Groundfish	↑	Fresh Haddock will continue to be available on a limited supply basis. We will not see relief until late spring, when certain fishing areas are reopened.

Market Update

Category	Up/Down/Flat	News Flash
Beef	→	Choice graded ribeyes stabilized this week. Demand seems to have slaved. Expect moderate relief after the first of the year.
Poultry	↑	Chicken production cutbacks continue. Fresh chicken wing prices continue to rise due to high seasonal demand.
Milk	↓	Manufacturing milk supplies in the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast regions were below expectations and below previous year's levels for the holiday period. The lower than expected manufacturing milk supplies resulted from fluid milk price discounts. Market for December down slightly.
Cheese	↓	The cheese market may have seasonally peaked. In the last 5 Decembers, the CME cheese block market has declined an average of 11%.
Butter	↓	Butter prices have weakened in recent weeks. Further declines may be forthcoming. The butter market in Dec has dropped an average of 20 cents per pound over the prior 7 years.
Oil	→	The soybean oil market recently achieved a new 2011 price low due in part to perceived softness in demand. Lower soybean oil prices from here should be modest at best.
Flour	→	Flour prices are down this week. Wheat futures are following corn and soybeans lower. The basis levels have also weakened. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Farmers' sales have increased with the focus on the fall harvest crops. · Harvest has begun in Australia and Argentina with good crops expected.
Sugar	→	Some See Raw Sugar Being Sweet To Year-End. Raw-sugar futures in New York trade higher on a boost from a weaker dollar, and some bargain-buying may mean the uptrend could continue all month.
