Market Update

Category	Up/Down/Flat	News Flash
Beef		Round values held at steady levels, with some slight negative pressure surfacing late in the week for inside rounds.
Poultry		Following two short kill weeks for the holidays, coupled with ongoing industry cutbacks, product availability has tightened across most points of sale. Wings are just plain short. Orders outweigh offerings allowing premium prices to continue.
Milk		USDA expects dairy exports to decline some, especially for cheese and butter, but yet remain favorable. If this holds and milk production slows milk prices could well improve the second half of 2012, but are likely to still average below 2011 for the year.
Cheese		Natural cheese orders are better than process demand at this time. Cheese cutters and packagers have been working reduced holiday schedules and slowing demand. Cheese plants are seeing increased milk offerings due to the holidays.
Butter		Butter orders are lighter this week as buyers assess holiday carryover volumes and prepare for the New Year. In many instances, buyers are hesitant to place large orders as many anticipate weaker prices in the New Year. Butter sales during the final quarter of 2011 have been much stronger than earlier anticipated.
Oil		Soybean oil rolled over to March futures and rose sharply early this week on weather trading. Continued weeks of dryness in Argentina and Parana, Brazil's second largest soy producing state, have caused irreversible losses to some soybean crop development. Short term prices should move higher.
Flour		Wheat futures prices are mixed this week; spring futures were down and winter futures were up a bit.. Basis levels were also mixed with spring lower and winter steady making winter wheat flour pricing up.
Sugar		Demand for sweeteners remains strong but, short term supplies remain adequate. Pricing stable for Feb.
