Market Update

Category	Up/Down/Flat	News Flash
Beef	↓	Ribeye and tenderloin markets have started to decline, holiday sales are over and demand will continue to drop.
Poultry	↑	Spot chicken producer profitability last week improved to its best level since Nov '10 due to a modest decrease in feed costs and a rise in most chicken markets. That being said, last week was still the 2nd worst producer profitability for that week in 7 years. Chicken producers may continue to reduce future chicken output as a result. Chicken wing prices continue to rise.
Milk	→	Class I demand has declined, but is expected to increase next week when most primary and secondary schools resume on January 3.
Cheese	→	The CME Group cash cheese market is about steady at generally lighter holiday demand. The current week CME Group block average of \$1.5625 is well above the comparable 2010 week average of \$1.3225. The current week barrel average of \$1.5500 is also well above the \$1.3725 average last year. Many buyers are positioning for the yearend inventory taking and waiting for the results of holiday movement before reordering .
Butter	→	The CME cash butter price dipped under the \$1.6000 level early in the week and remains at \$1.5950 at week's end. Churning activities across the country are starting to increase as surplus cream offerings build. Early in the week, surplus cream volumes were already being reported and are anticipated to only become heavier as the holiday weekend approaches. Butter demand has tapered off this week as butter needs have been shipped for the upcoming holiday
Oil	→	The general trend for soybeans for the first part of 2012 looks to be down, but the break into Mid-December has left the market a bit oversold, and a bounce might be expected in the near term. In addition, a dry weather forecast for Argentina and southern Brazil is threatening to disrupt production.
Flour	→	Wheat futures prices advanced this week. Basis remained steady. Support came from outside markets. U.S. equity indexes, crude oil & gold are all up this week. Weakness in the U.S. dollar also played a role in wheat prices advancing.
Sugar	→	Traders see a significant world production deficit this year and another one for next year. This continuing trend of demand outpacing supplies will keep sugar prices firm to higher in 2012.
